Some of us will give up something or abstain from some activity during this forty day period known as Lent. Enhance this symbolic gesture by spending some extra quiet time with Jesus. As we move through this period leading up to Easter and the resurrection of our Lord, I urge you to spend time with God and explore ways to spend one on one time with Him. In our hectic world it seems there are just not enough hours in the day to dedicate a few minutes in renewing our relationship with Him. #### Mission Jar Outreach

Celebrate Recovery is a Christ-based approach to recovery that was a response to twelve-step programs such as Alcoholics Anonymous. It was founded in 1990 by Pastors John Baker and Rick Warren of Saddleback Church, and is aimed at all "hurts, habits, and hangups", including but not limited to drug and alcohol addictions, sex addiction, eating disorders, and people who have been sexually abused. The founders felt that Alcoholics Anonymous was too vague in referring to God as a "higher power," and wanted a more specifically Christ-based program. Celebrate Recovery utilizes eight Recovery Principles that are based on the Sermon on the Mount.
