Greetings from your Pastor,

I greet you with the words of Paul who was writing to the faithful in Rome before he had a chance to visit them. Paul is acknowledging the faithfulness of the church in Rome for the spreading of the gospel among Jews and Gentiles alike. My prayer for Lakeside has been the same as Paul's for the early church, that we would be in the forefront of bringing Christ's light into a dark world. As we prepare for the coming of our Savior during the Advent season, let's be mindful of how each of us can be the light for someone who finds themselves engulfed by the darkness. This time of year can be lonely and stressful for many of us. As we show the face of Christ to those who find themselves in that sad place, remember how you felt when Jesus became your best friend. When the opportunity arises, be the face of Christ for someone looking for the light.

I am reminded of the story of Zacharias and Elisabeth, who had prayed for a child but seemed destined to not succeed. They had given up on the dream. And then the angel shows up and gives them the good news. They had thought their prayer had gone unanswered. Then the angel told them they would have a son whose sole purpose would be to prepare Israel for the coming of the Messiah, Jesus. This all sounded impossible to Zacharias; Not the miracle that Jesus would come, but that John would be the forerunner. Zacharias, as a believing Jew, knew the Scriptures and believed this. He just had a hard time thinking God could use silly old him. After all, he and his wife were well beyond the age to have children. He did something many of us do. We believe in the BIG things of God, like sending his son to be our Savior, but when it comes to the "little" things, we limit Him. Yes, God can create the earth in six days, be born as a baby, and send us to Heaven, but He can't possibly change me, fix a relationship, or get me a job.

But God's answer is **Yes I can**! You see, the biggest miracle has already been done Jesus. Everything else is small to God. (Crosswalk.com)
