They reduce Him simply to a Big Friend who will help us when we are in trouble. That is not Biblical Christianity! Jesus Christ is Lord, and when an individual comes in repentance and faith, the truth flashes in. For the first time he finds himself saying, "I will do the will of the Lord, even if I die for it!"

Those words should shake our very foundation. Are you willing to go that far for Christ? My hope for you is that Jesus Christ has revealed himself to you in a new way this Easter season and with "Pentecostal Fire Falling" you are facing the world with renewed courage and vigor. We are an Easter people filled with the promise of Pentecostal fire and we should live like it. Let the world know of the gift you have been given in Jesus Christ. In Hebrews 9:12 it says, "but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, having obtained eternal redemption." This is the gift the world needs to hear about today.

My prayer for each of you is to experience a safe and healthy summer. May the God of grace and peace be easily recognized as we move forward in sharing this Jesus with others.




