Needs: underwear, socks, sneakers, solid color collared school shirts, shorts (khaki or black).

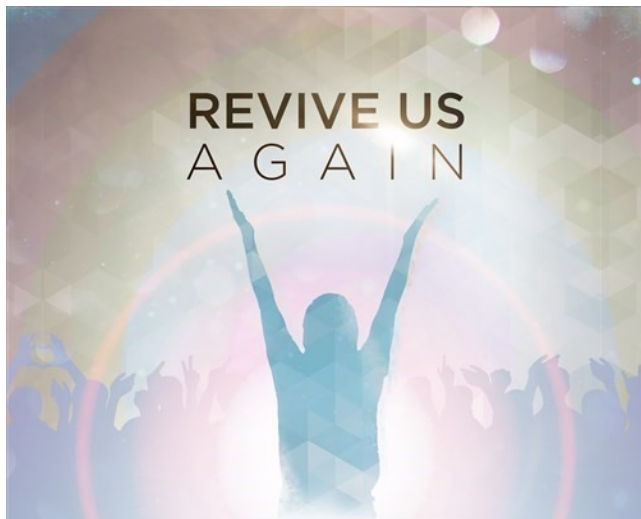

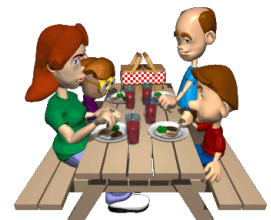

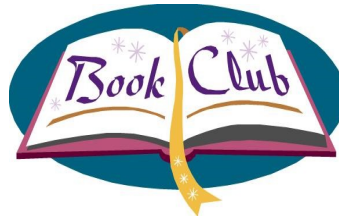

## CARD MINISTRY

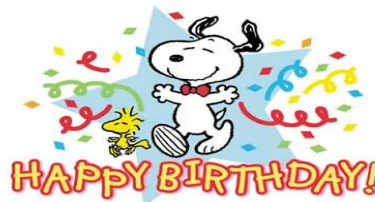
You ask why we have a Card Ministry?

## Trinity Sunday, June 11, 2017

**Do United Methodists believe in the Holy Trinity?** Yes! The Articles of Religion state that the Godhead is "three persons, of one substance, power, and eternity—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost." In Methodist congregations all over the world, we say as a gathered body that we "believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth; And in Jesus Christ his only Son, our Lord; who was conceived by the Holy Spirit." But, explaining the Trinity remains challenging for us.

Trinity Sunday is celebrated on the Sunday after Pentecost, reminding us of the three different ways we experience the one God whom we worship. We worship God the Creator; we worship Jesus who experienced the life of a human; and we worship the way that God works within us - the Holy Spirit.

**Salty Service is one of the Missional Vital Signs that our church reports on each month to show our church’s growth.**
