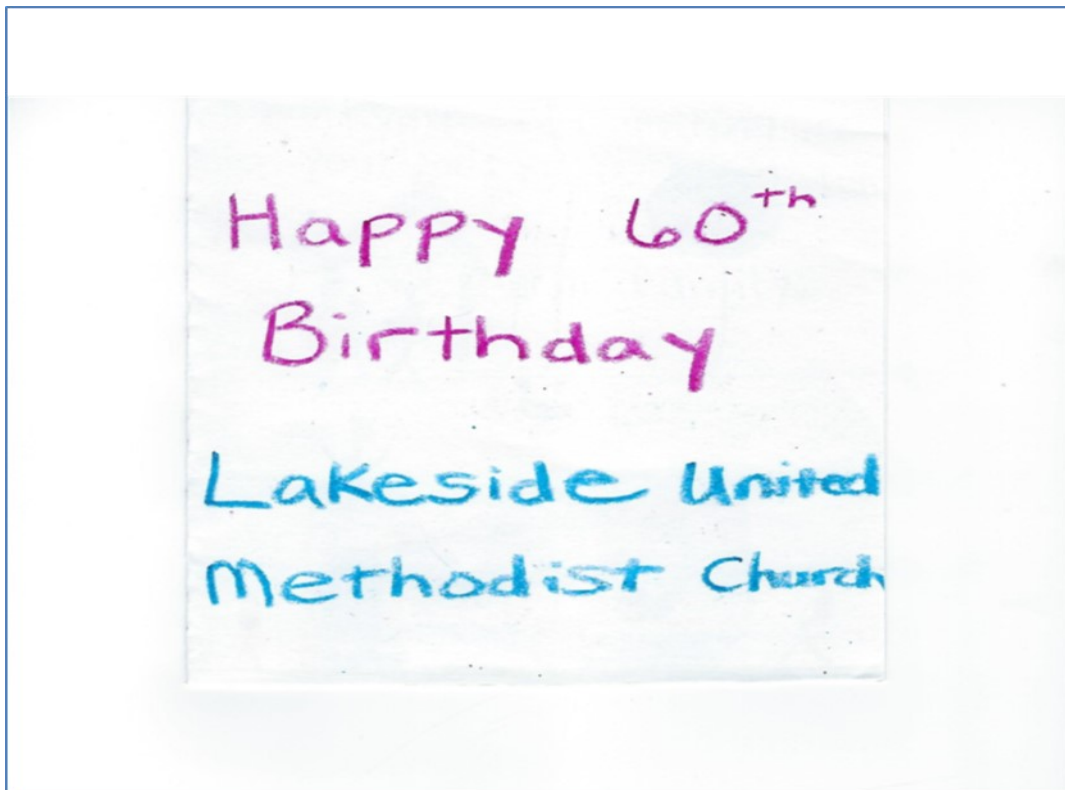

Lakeside has a nursery for babies, ages birth through Pre-K, during the Sunday morning church service beginning at 9:45 am.

Our Sunday School class is for grades K-3. Children remain in church with their parents until the Children's Sermon. After that, they are escorted to the Youth Room for their class. Our curriculum is designed for lower elementary ages.

On the first Sunday of every month, Pastor David has requested all school-aged children remain in the sanctuary to participate in Holy Communion with their families.

CURRENT DISASTER RESPONSE

UMCOR and our partners are responding to Hurricane Florence in the United States and Super Typhoon Mangkhut (Ompong) in the Philippines. Please join us in prayer for the areas affected and consider a gift to UMCOR Disaster Response. As we assess the impact of these storms, we will provide timely updates as we receive information.

Hurricane Florence

As of 8am on Sept. 20, UMCOR is pleased to report that conferences are as prepared as possible to respond to the damage caused by Hurricane Florence. We ask that those wishing to assist to please not self-deploy or donate unsolicited items. We anticipate additional updates related to Florence emergent needs and will provide such as we receive them.

In North Carolina, Disaster Response Coordinators and Early Response Teams will assess damage in the areas hardest hit by Hurricane Florence later this week and into the weekend. However, some areas affected by Hurricanes Matthew and Irene were not affected by Hurricane Florence and are still in need of long-term recovery volunteers. 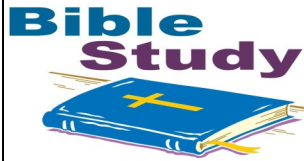

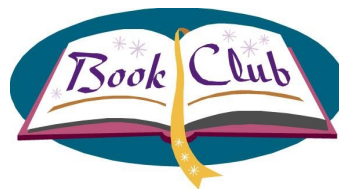
UMM MEN
