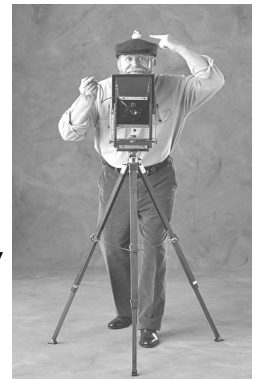


Thanksgiving Eve Service 7:00 PM Wednesday, November 21st.

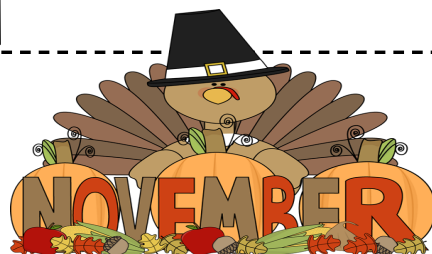

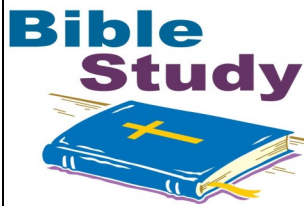

THANKSGIVING HOLIDAY- the church office will be closed Thursday, November 22nd and Friday, November 23rd.

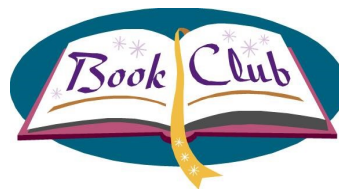
UMM MEN

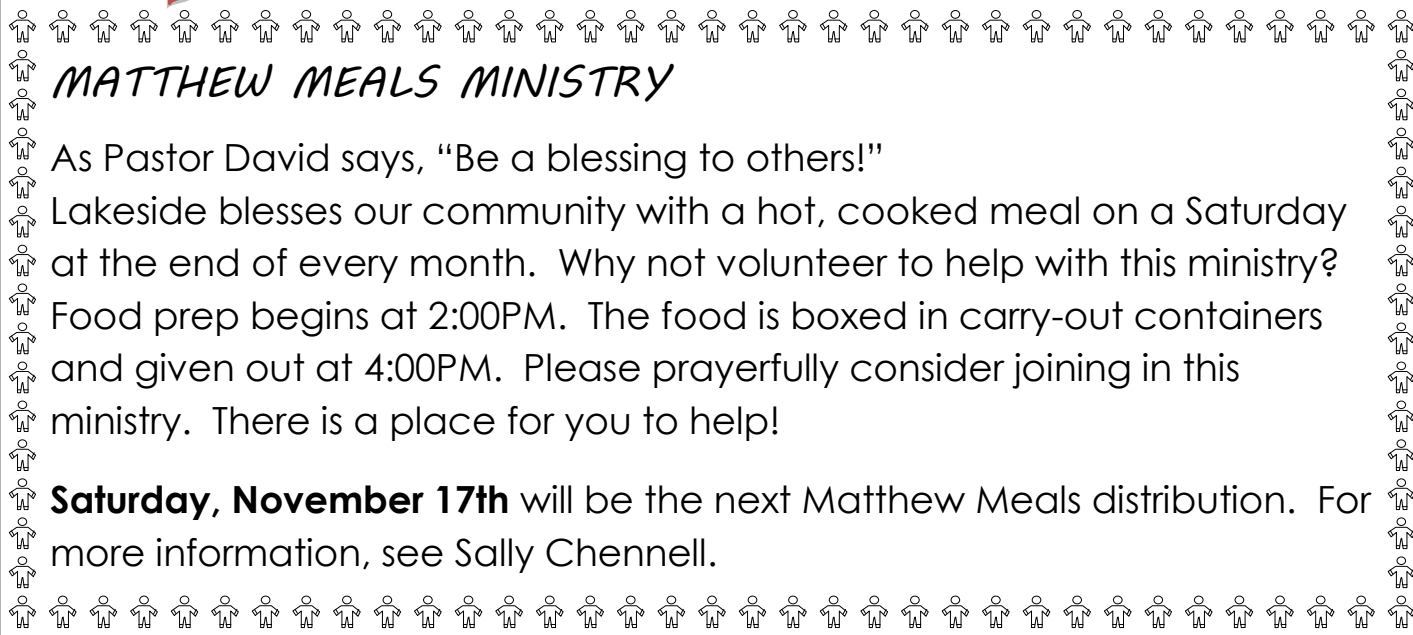

You see, they typically struggle with self worth. Thus, reflecting on their progress becomes essential to help them see they are successful and can accomplish great things. One should never let their past define their future. Our children have suffered from abuse, abandonment and neglect. But with your support, they can accomplish great things.

Can you imagine how these children feel? They don't believe that they can ever experience the kind of love that most children take for granted. They are beginning to realize what they are achieving. Your support is helping our children to believe that they can be successful and loved.
