CROS MINISTRIES PROGRAMS

CROS Gleaning harvested 604,674 pounds of fresh produce which was distributed to local food programs by the Palm Beach County Food Bank.

(2018-2019 Gleaning Season)

190,000+ Palm Beach County residents depend on federal food assistance for daily sustenance.

CROS Camps served 13,846 meals to 177 campers representing 112 Palm Beach County families during summer 2019.

Children in a food insecure household are two times more likely to have mental and health issues.

CROS Community Food Pantries distributed food to 71,444 individuals, 35% of whom were children in 2018.

CROS Ministries' hunger programs are designed to provide food to people living in at-risk communities so they can use their limited resources on other basic needs.

In *Light of the World: A Beginner's Guide to Advent*, author, professor, and biblical scholar Amy-Jill Levine explores the biblical texts surrounding the story of the birth of Jesus. 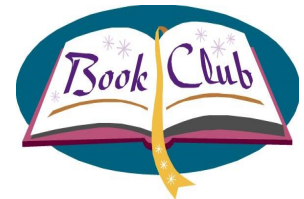

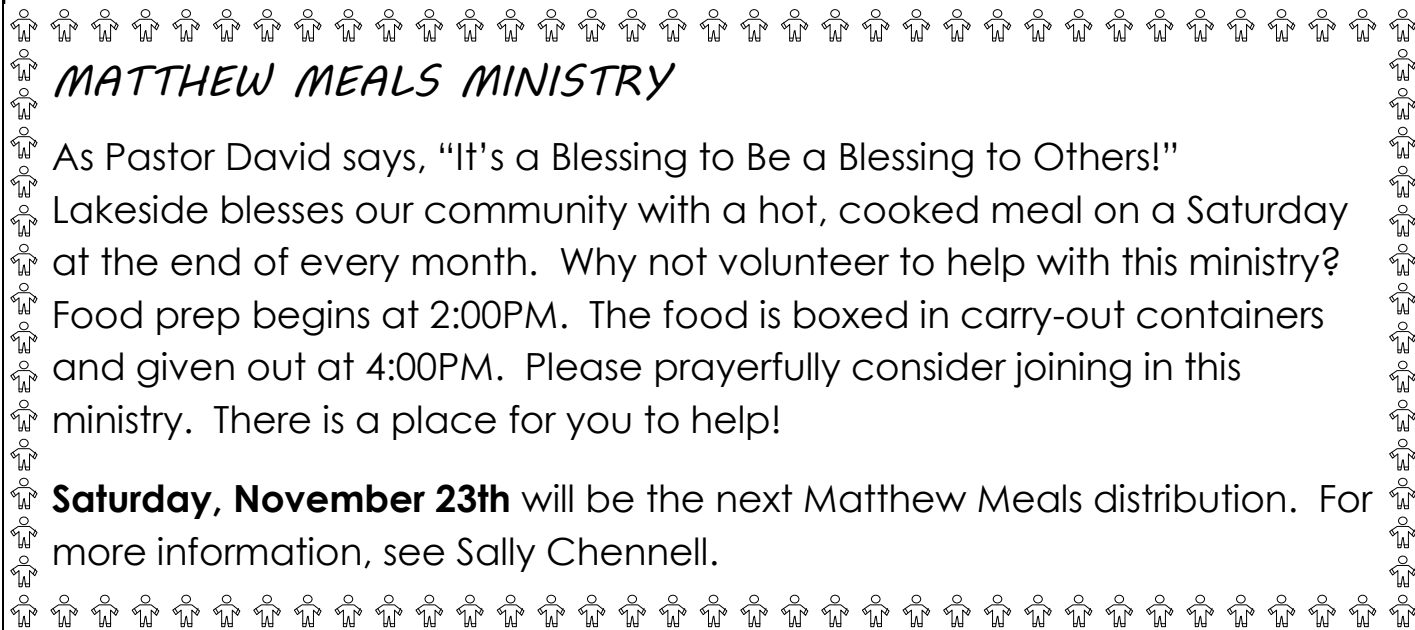
