After much consternation and prayer, we have devised a plan to allow a small number of our folks to join us for worship on Saturdays at 10:00 a.m. when we do the recording of our Sunday worship service. This invitation will be by reservation only. We will allow 10 people with a reservation for that week to enter at 9:45 ia.m. observing facial covering and sanitizing guidelines from the CDC and the UM Con-! ference. We will be seating with social distancing in mind in designated seats that you will be escorted to by an usher. If you live in the same household with someone you will be able to be seated together, otherwise a minimum of 20 ft. distance will be maintained. An usher will be taking your temperature as you enter the sanctuary These regulations may seem unreasonable to you but I am taking the utmost caution in protecting people that I love, and that's YOU! If for some reason we run into difficulty maintaining these protocols we will suspend the services until it is deemed safe to gather. You may make your reservation as early as today by contacting me by email or cell phone (561-389-6763) If we have more than 10, your name will be moved to the list for the following week. A first come first served !timestamp of correspondence will be used to determine placement. If this works well we may be able to increase attendance in the near future. It is important that everyone gets counted. The census is so important that your response is required by law, and your answers are kept completely confidential. If you do not respond, they will need to send a Census Bureau interviewer to your home to collect your answers in person. If you need help completing your 2020 Census questionnaire, please call toll-free 1-844-330-2020.

If someone visits your home this year to collect information for the 2020 Census, check to make sure they have a valid ID badge with their photograph, a U.S. Department of Commerce watermark, and an expiration date. Census workers may also carry Census Bureau bags

How to Prepare for a Hurricane

Now/Prepare

Sign up for local alerts and warnings. Monitor local news and weather reports. Prepare to evacuate by testing your emergency communication plan(s), learning evacuation routes, having a place to stay, and packing a "go bag." Stock emergency supplies. Protect your property by installing sewer backflow valves, anchoring fuel tanks, reviewing insurance policies, and cataloging belongings. Collect and safeguard critical financial, medical, educational, and legal documents and records.

During/Survive

Follow guidance from local authorities. If advised to evacuate, grab your "go bag" and leave immediately. For protection from high winds, stay away from windows and seek shelter on the lowest level in an interior room. Move to higher ground if there is flooding or a flood warning. Turn Around Don't Drown.® Never walk or drive on flooded roads or through water. Call 9 -1-1 if you are in life-threatening danger.

After/Be Safe

Return to the area only after authorities say it is safe to do so. Do not enter damaged buildings until they are inspected by qualified professionals. Never walk or drive on flooded roads or through floodwaters. Look out for downed or unstable trees, poles, and power lines. Do not remove heavy debris by yourself. Wear gloves and sturdy, thick-soled shoes to protect your hands and feet. Do not drink tap water unless authorities say it is safe.
