"Led By a God of Hope"

Veteran Global Ministries missionary Rev. Claudia Genung-Yamamoto charts new ministry paths in Japan. She has a gift for connection, a valuable skill for a pastor in Japan, where only one percent of the population professes faith in Jesus Christ.

It also comes in handy at Kobe Union Church, where Rev. Genung-Yamamoto oversees community outreach and church development for a congregation that, in addition to serving Japanese nationals, also draws attendees from other parts of Asia as well as from Africa, Europe, and the United States. The diverse mix of cultures and people presents a joyful challenge. "I am privileged to see God at work in my efforts to connect people to people, people to the resources they need, and people to God," she says.

Rev. Genung-Yamamoto recalls a young Japanese man named Masa. A regular attendee, Masa struggled with severe autism and chronic agitation and worry. She connected Masa to helpful resources and coached him in how to exercise self-restraint through trust in God and the exercise of breath prayer, an ancient, rhythmic form of prayer tied to breathing. "Masa really improved his ability to control his anxiety through prayer." For me, his example is a symbol of hope and transformation."

When the worldwide COVID-19 pandemic hit, unexpected complications resulted. Suddenly, Rev. Genung-Yamamoto and her fellow church leaders were forced to identify new modalities for offering worship and pastoral care and to find new ways to support church and local community members who lost jobs or became further estranged from social services. "A new paradigm emerged from this crisis, and we have found alternative ways to do church and reach out to others," she says.

Church and Mission giving – Our giving has to be modified to accommodate the reality that not all of us are comfortable gathering in person to worship right now. Electronic giving through PayPal is the best way of giving from home. Many of you are already on our giving platform.
