
4 Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice.

OLD PLANTATION PECAN PIE, Robynne Ryals

1 9" single crust pastry 1/3 c. firmly packed brown sugar 1 ¹/₂ tsp. flour ¹/₄ light corn syrup

4 eggs 1 ½ tsp. vanilla ¼ c. butter, melted 1 c. pecan halves or pieces

Heat oven to 375. Prepare pastry. In large bowl, combine brown sugar, flour, corn syrup, eggs and vanilla; beat well. Stir in margarine and pecans. Pour into pastry-lined pie pan. Bake at 375 for 35-45 minute or until center of pie is puffed and golden brown. Cool.
