"Father's Day" History

On July 5, 1908, a West Virginia church sponsored the nation's first event explicitly in honor of fathers. It was a Sunday sermon in memory of the 362 men who had died in the previous December's mine explosion, but it was a one-time commemoration and not an annual holiday.

The next year, Sonora Smart Dodd, one of six children raised by a widower, tried to establish an official equivalent to Mother's Day for male parents. She went to local churches, the YMCA, shopkeepers, and government officials to drum up support for her idea, and she was successful.

Our nation's first Father's Day was celebrated on June 19, 1910, in the state of Washington at the YMCA. However, it was not until 1972 (58 years after President Woodrow Wilson made Mother's Day official that the day honoring fathers became a nationwide holiday in the United States.

Most countries around the world celebrate Father's Day on the third Sunday of June.

What does the Bible say about father's day?

Psalm 103:13: "As a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear him."

Proverbs 22:6: "Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it."

2 Samuel 7:14-15: "I will be a father to him, and he'll be a son to me.

Dear Father in Heaven, for those who are fathers, we ask for wisdom and humility in the face of the task of parenting. Give them the strength to do well by their children and by You. In Your Holy name, O God, we pray. Amen.
