A survey conducted by LifeWay Research found that:

- 48% of church attendees have not personally invited an unchurched person to attend a church service or some other program at their church.
- 33% of people say they've personally invited someone one or two times, and
- 19% say they've done so on three or more occasions in the last six months.

While the efficacy of personal invitations may be changing, it is still worth extending an invitation to someone you think might be interested in attending church. It is important to remember that everyone has different reasons for attending church, and some may be more receptive to an invitation than others.

Here at Lakeside we invite you to bring a guest every Sunday. Richard and I are the products of a church invite in 2004 that led us to both our callings in ministry and our ordinations. Everyone has spiritual gifts and we are all equipped to do kingdom work in whatever capacity God calls us.

"And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved." Acts 2:47, NLT

This verse speaks to church growth; it does not provide a specific formula or strategy for achieving it. Instead, it emphasizes the importance of faith in Jesus Christ as the foundation for any successful ministry.

As a pastor who witnessed significant church growth at my last appointment, I know that personal invitations are very effective in achieving church growth. It takes all of us to support the ministry and effect church health and vitality.



### **September Starts Salty Service Season**

Matthew 5:13 states, "You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how can its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything but is thrown out and trampled underfoot."

One definition for being a faithful "Salty" servant, according to the Bible, is to be a devoted and helpful follower of God, to be humble before God, to be ready to act as God nudges and inspires us, to help meet the needs of other people, and to remember that it is not about money or reward.

Salty Service refers to the projects, efforts, and work people do to make a positive difference in the lives of others for the purposes of Christ, whether or not they will ever become part of the community of faith.

On the back of your Connect Card is a box to mark each week that you have done a "Salty Service" for someone that was not an obligation, but a kind and helpful deed, completed out of the goodness of your heart without any expectation of reward.


Church and Mission giving – We are again passing the collection plates during Worship Service.
